

Truckee Day Instructions for Volunteers

- Have a hearty breakfast!
- Check in to your station starting at 8:00 AM Saturday, June 5. T-shirts given to volunteers first-come, first served.
- You'll sign a waiver, get your t-shirt, BBQ ticket and bags, and be assigned a stretch of road within your neighborhood. You may have to drive to a specific stretch of road.
- What to wear:
 1. long sleeve pants and shirt (bright colors recommended)
 2. sunglasses and hat
 3. sunscreen and bug repellent
 4. gloves
 5. sturdy shoes or boots
- What to pick up: *roadside trash only*. Anything larger may be placed by the side of the road with a bag attached for visibility. Please place mangled **and** downed snow-poles (town-owned only – they're steel) next to full trash bags and they will be gathered by town employees later.
- DO NOT trespass on private property! A rule of thumb is to stay on the road side of utility poles or utility boxes.
- Be traffic-aware. You are on public roads and competing for lane space with automobile traffic.
- Your whole family is welcome. All adults will sign waivers for themselves and children in their care. NO children will be allowed to be dropped off; they must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- What to put in the blue bags: Batteries, bottles, and cans. Dry newspaper only; if it is waterlogged please place it in your trash bag.
- Where to put the bags: leave both colors of full bags, with the tops tightly knotted closed, on the side of the road. If you clean a cul-de-sac, please bring the bags to the closest intersection.
- This will last approximately 1 – 2 hours, as long as you can stand it or until your stretch of road is done, whichever comes first.

Head to Truckee River Regional Park at Noon for BBQ and music!
